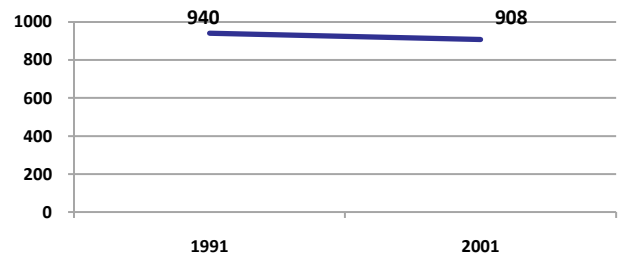

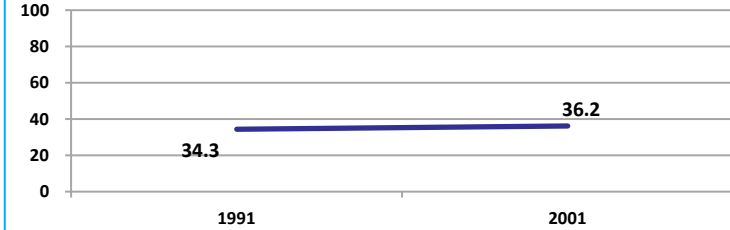

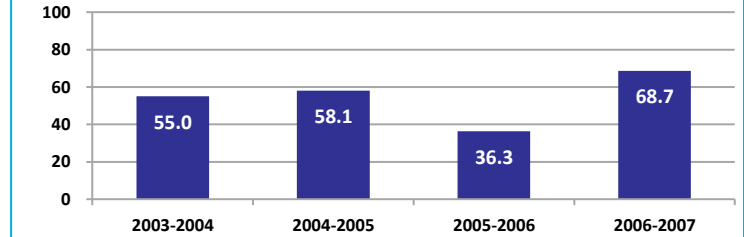

Net sown area irrigated

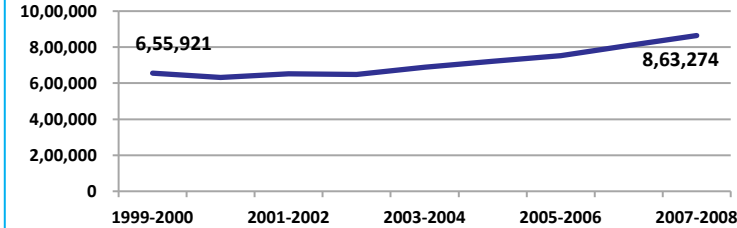

Net district domestic product at constant (1990-2000) prices

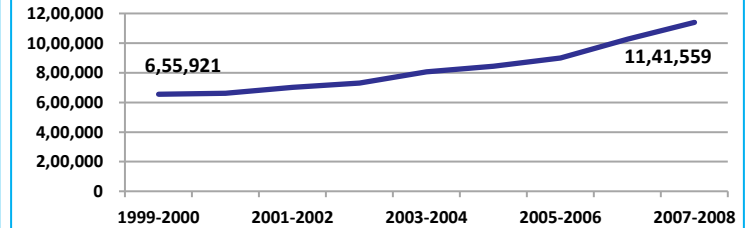

Net district domestic product at current prices

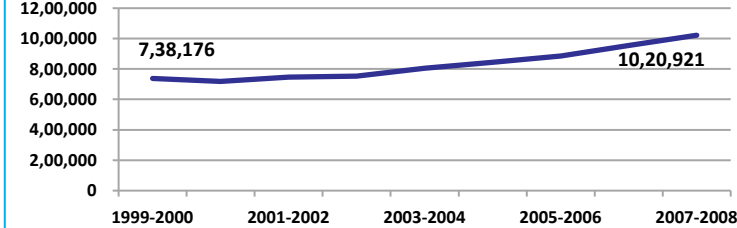

Gross district domestic Product at constant (1990-2000) prices

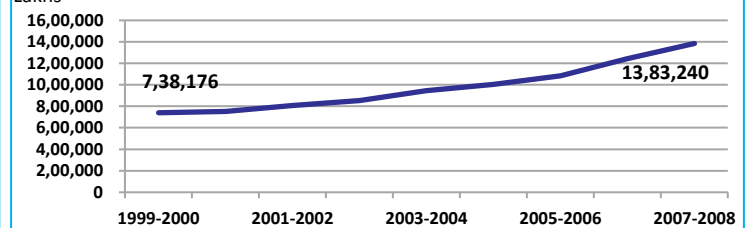

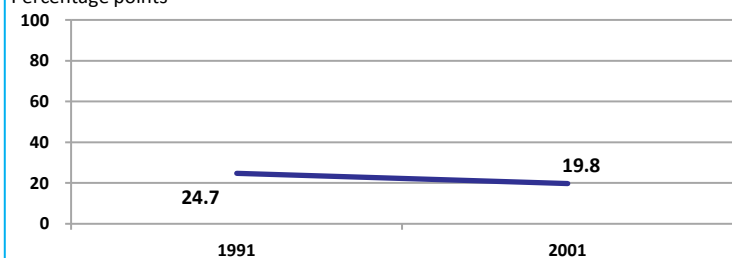

Gender gap in literacy rate (Male-Female)

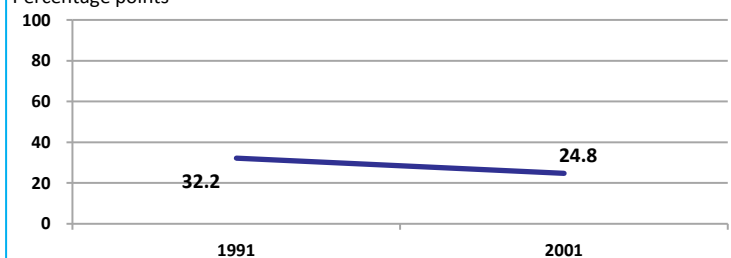

Percentage points



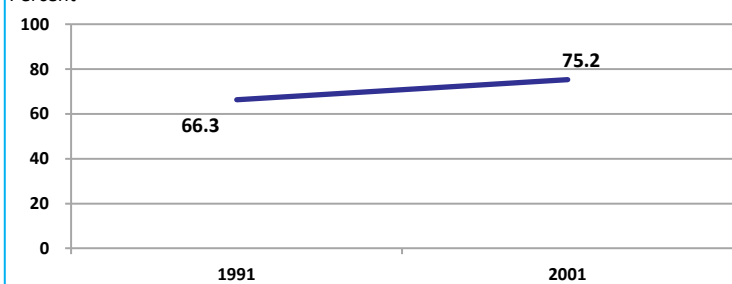

Literacy rate 7+

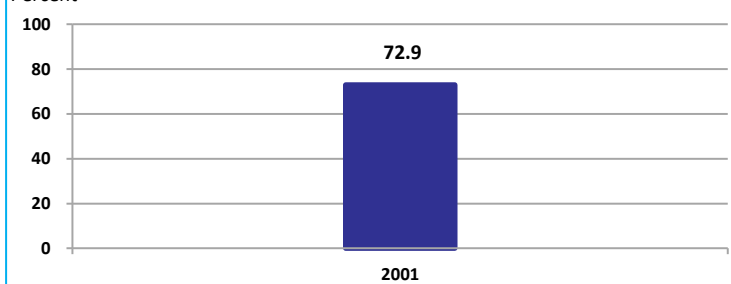

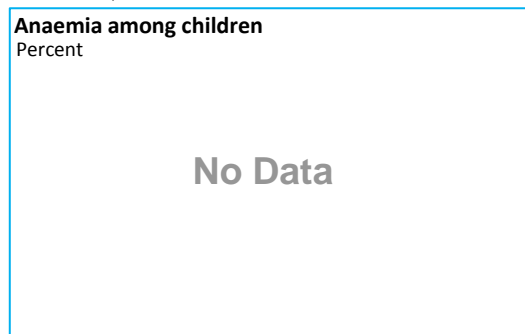

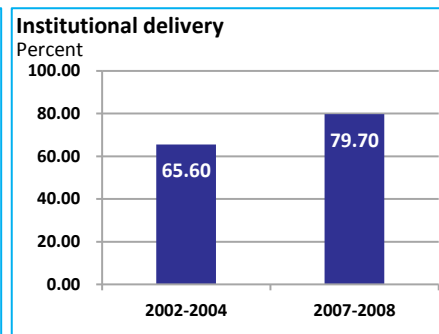

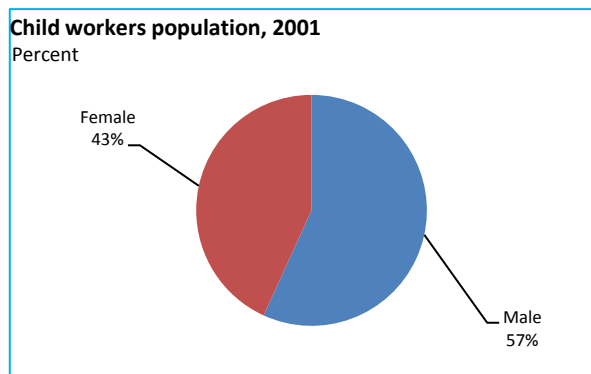

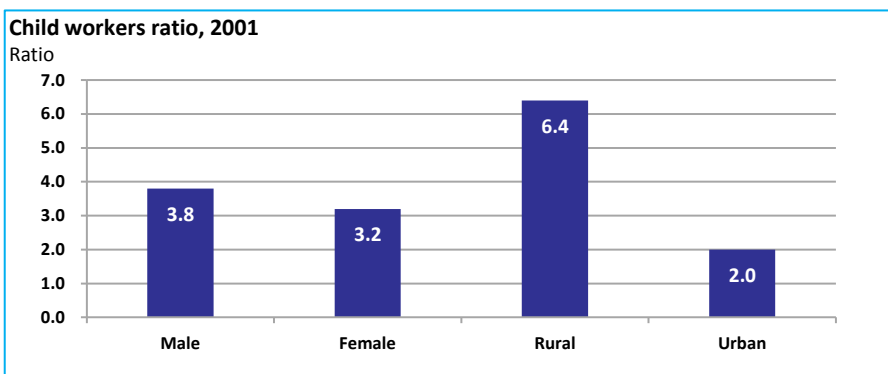
