Gender gap in literacy rate (Male-Female)

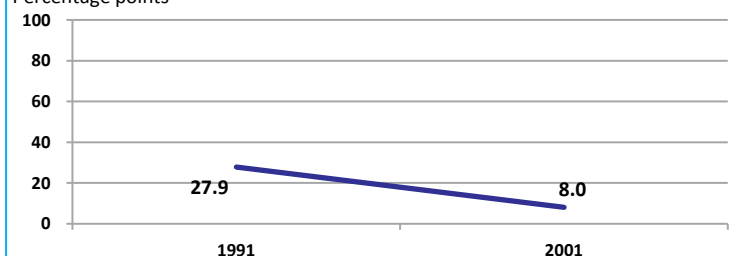

Percentage points



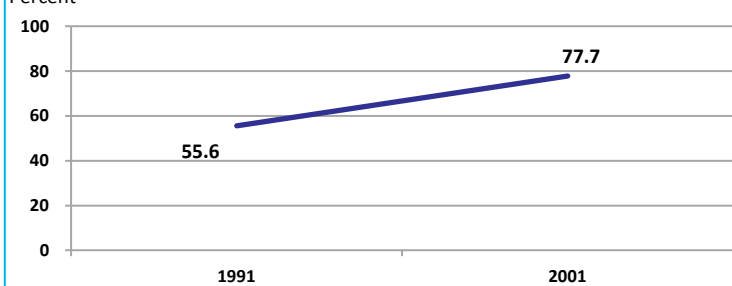

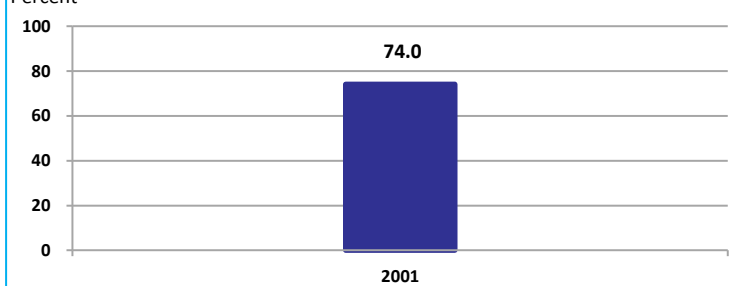
