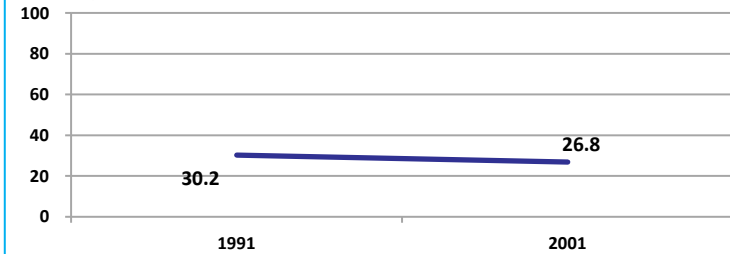

#### Gender gap in literacy rate (Male-Female)

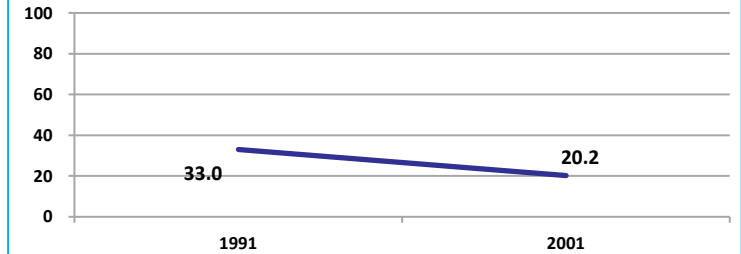

Percentage points



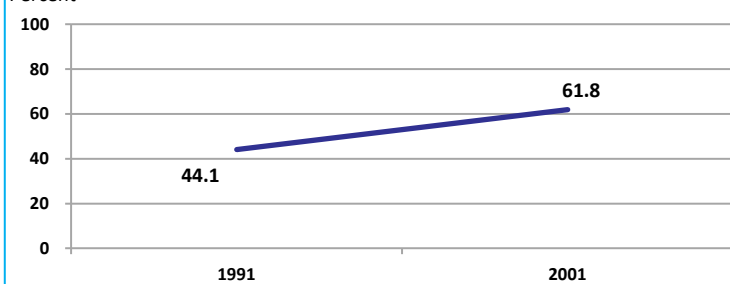

#### Literacy rate 7+

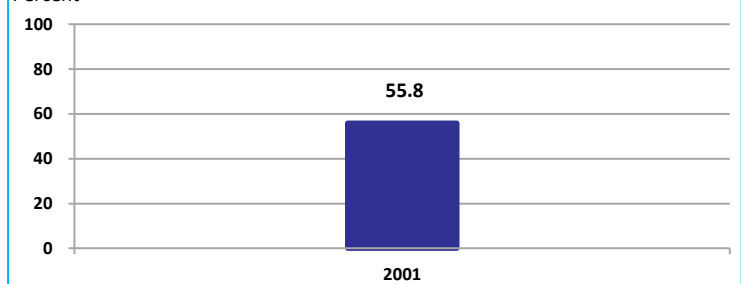

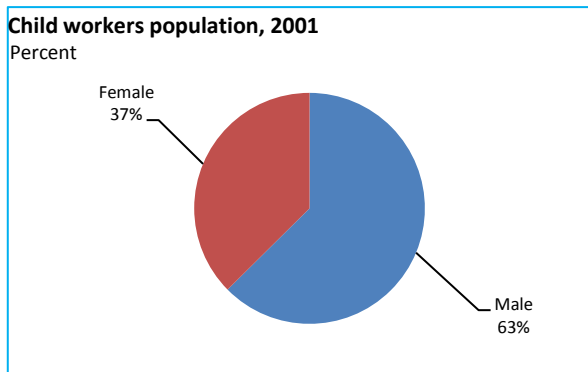

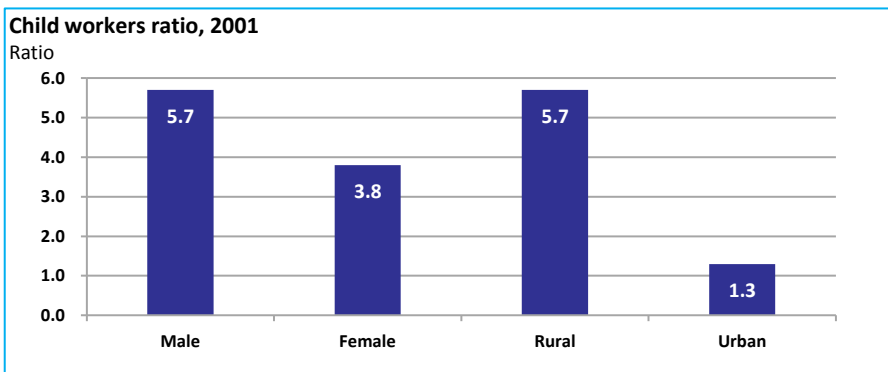
