# Sustainable Development Goals

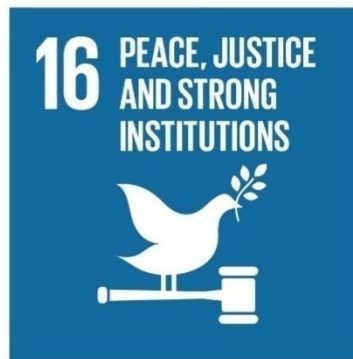
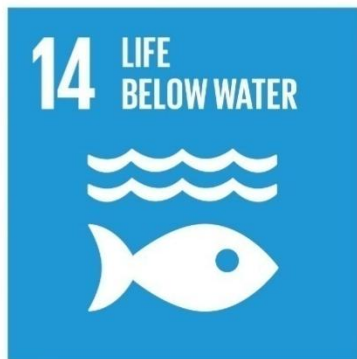
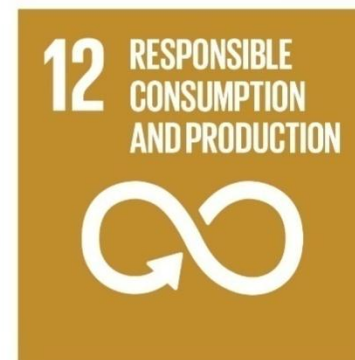
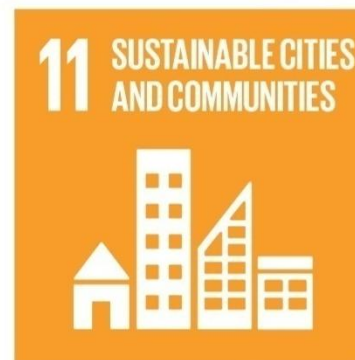
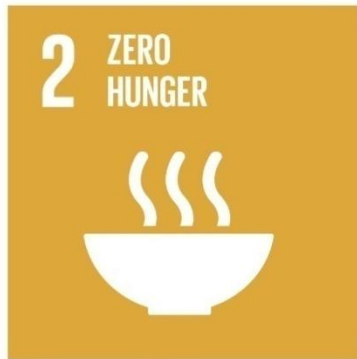
- ❖ The SDGs for 2030 evolved from the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) for 2015. The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) were born at the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development in Rio de Janeiro in 2012.
- ❖ SDGs are the bold universal set of 17 Goals and 169 targets to help organise and streamline development actions for greater achievement of human wellbeing, while leaving no one behind – by 2030.
- ❖ In Sep 2016 NITI Aayog has been charged with the responsibility of coordinating the implementation of the SDGs in India; collecting data periodically, and act proactively to fructify the goals and targets not only quantitatively but also maintaining high standards of quality
- ❖ Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) has drafted the National Indicator Framework comprising of 306 Indicators.

# SDG India Index 2018

- ❖ NITI Aayog has constructed the SDG India Index spanning across 13 out of 17 SDGs.
- ❖ The Index tracks the progress of all the States and UTs on a set of 62 Priority Indicators.
- ❖ Out of 62 priority indicators 58 are covered in State Action Plan.

# Approach Adopted

## Taskforce For SDGs

The process of preparation of SDG Vision 2030 began in December 2016 with formation of 09 Task Forces.

## Consultation with Departments

For preparing Vision 2030 rounds of consultation and sensitization workshops were conducted by all taskforces during 2017-18.

## SDG Vision

Based on the compiled data received from various taskforces, the Vision 2030 has been prepared and approved the Chief Secretary and disseminated to state government departments in Oct 2018 with the request to start working on their action plan



# Institutionalization and Localization

- ❖ Dedicated interdepartmental SDG cell has been constituted on Nov 2018 for monitoring the roll out and implementation of Sustainable Development Goals 2030 in Madhya Pradesh
- ❖ For Localization of SDGs in Madhya Pradesh we have also constituted a SDG cell in Nov 2018 under chairmanship of District Collector with district level officials of the concerning District departments as members in all the districts.

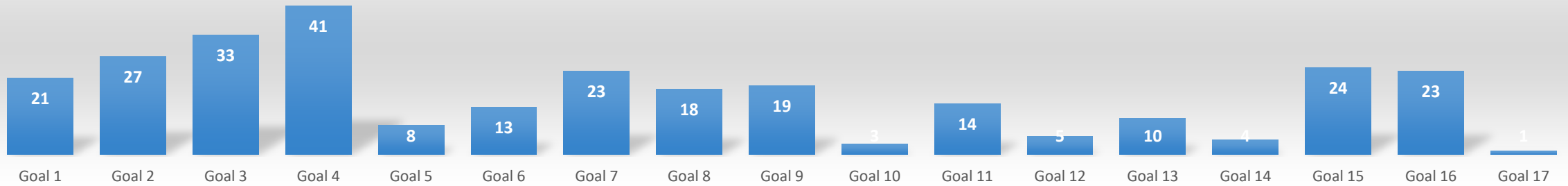


# Draft Action Plan

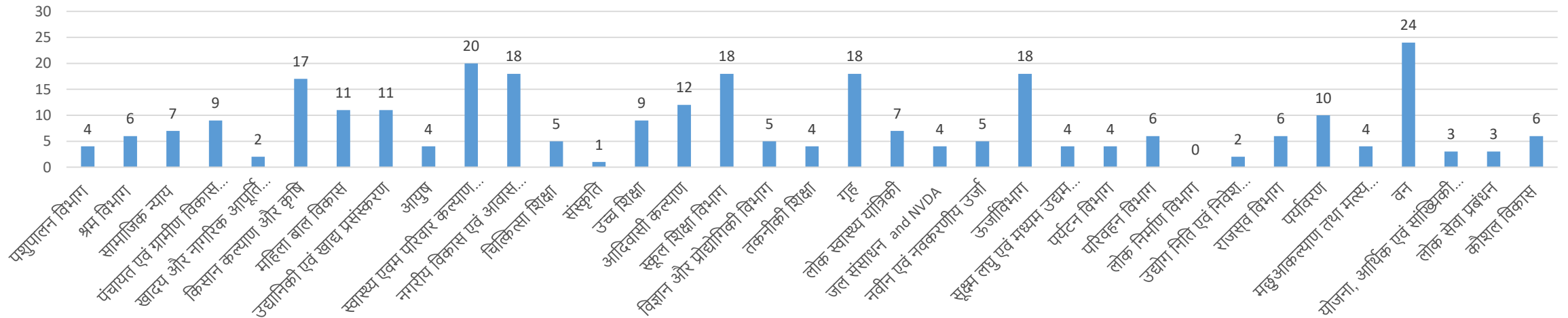
- ❖ Dedicated interdepartmental SDG cell conducted a rounds of consultations with departments and prepared a draft action plan, which is a compilation of the strategies adopted by the respective departments.
- ❖ Strategies are mapped to schemes and which are further mapped to measurable indicators having with physical targets and indicators for 2020, 2024 and 2030 related schemes.
- ❖ There are 35 departments with 287 indicators mapped in action plan document. Majority of indicators are of Health (20) , Forest (24), School Education (18) , Energy (18) and Agriculture (17).
- ❖ Our intent of this workshop is to take valuable feedback and suggestion from civil society, academia and line departments which will be incorporated in SDG action plans.
