
During the meeting, the main focus was on boosting the Economic competitiveness of Madhya Pradesh and an action plan on how to overcome such gaps. Some of the areas which ADB proposed were issues pertaining to job creation, heavy dependency on agriculture and lack of opportunities for research and capacity building. Along with this, the second focus of the meeting was the discussion on the findings of the study conducted by ADB in collaboration with NITI Aayog titled 'Cities as Engines of Growth' where two cities of Madhya Pradesh were included *viz.* Indore and Dewas. An overarching objective of the project is to develop principles and frameworks for growth enabling urban governance and coordinated spatial planning


